**General Information:**

- \* After-Prom is an alcohol/chemical/drug-free celebration full of fun activities in a safe and supervised environment following the Junior/Senior Prom. It is an alternative to attending a house party and reduces the risk of a fatality or accident on Prom Night.
- \* Food provided: Qdoba, Chick-fil-A, Vocelli's, Rita's, Starbucks, and more.
- \* Fun offered: Inflatable obstacle course, laser tag, human foosball, Family Feud game, henna tattoos, caricature artists, casino games, dodge ball tournaments, coffee bar, rock climbing wall, and more.
- \* Prizes to win: Tons of gift cards for food & shopping & services, flat-screen smart TV, xBox One, PS4, Dorm Package, Beats wireless headphones & earbuds, hoverboard, drone, Under Armour Package, Fitbit, GoPro, large CASH prizes and so much more!
- \* Students **MUST** be present to win any prizes.

**Ticket Sales:**

- \* Tickets must be purchased prior to the event. No tickets sold at the door.
- \* Tickets for After-Prom are \$10 and will be on sale April 24-28 during all lunch shifts.
- \* Accepting cash or checks made payable to MHHS PTSA. After-Prom **cannot be combined with Prom payment.**
- \* MHHS Juniors and Seniors do not have to attend Prom to participate in After-Prom.
- \* MHHS Juniors and Seniors may buy one ticket for themselves and one for a guest.
- \* Guests who are not MHHS Juniors or Seniors **MUST** attend Prom to attend After-Prom.
- \* Forms signed by student and his/her parent (if student is under 18) must be completed for EACH ticket purchased:
  1. Accident Waiver/Release of Liability and Permission Form (required)
  2. Y of Central Maryland Waiver Form (optional - for rock wall climbing)
- \* Non-MHHS guests must also fill out and sign the forms.
- \* Students over the age of 18 may sign for themselves providing they present (in person) a valid I.D.
- \* **NEW:** PTSA has chartered 3 buses to drive students from the Prom dance to After-Prom. A limited number of tickets will be sold April 24-28 during all lunch shifts for \$5/ticket. Cash or checks payable to MHHS PTSA. **Can be combined with After-Prom tickets.**

**After-Prom Rules and Information:**

- \* **NO** student will be admitted after 1:30am. No exceptions.
- \* After-Prom is **NOT** a lock-in. A student may choose to leave at any time but may not return.
- \* Picture ID (driver's license or other state-issued ID) required for entry to After-Prom.
- \* All bags are subject to search at the discretion of MHHS PTSA. **No liquids are allowed in**, e.g. water bottles, perfume. Students may change in the YMCA locker rooms and then be escorted back to their vehicle to return their bag. The YMCA has lockers that can be used for storage, but students must provide their own locks. PTSA is not responsible for items brought to the After-Prom party.
- \* After-Prom is a PTSA sponsored event, not school sponsored. However, the HCPSS Student Code of Conduct rules (found at <http://www.hcpss.org/about-us/student-code-of-conduct/>) are in effect including, but not limited to: Alcohol Violation, Arson/Fire Violation, Bullying/Harassment, Property Damage, Disrespect, Drug Violation, Explosives, False Alarms/Bomb Threats, Fighting, Gang Activity, Indecent Exposure, Physical Attack, Serious Bodily Injury, Sexual Activity, Theft, Threat to Students, Tobacco Violation, and Weapons Violation.
- \* Violations of HCPSS Student Code of Conduct rules are grounds for removal from After-Prom. The offender's parent/guardian will be contacted in the event of violations of any rules of conduct resulting in expulsion from the event or intervention by police/security. Howard County Police and/or private security will be present and may take further action.
- \* MHHS students are responsible for the behavior of their non-MHHS guests.
